

The Senate: Statement of Primary Responsibilities and Delegations

Introduction

- The Senate Statement of Primary Responsibilities and Delegations (SSPRD) has been updated to reflect the new Charter and Statutes that were agreed by HM the Queen and the Privy Council in June 2019. The changes mainly related to updated references and terminology, however there are also three new provisions in Statute 5 to take into account. These are the final three sections below.
- 2. In line with the Constitutional Framework¹, the <u>Charter and Statutes</u>, and <u>Ordinances</u> have precedence over the Statement of Primary Responsibilities and Delegated Authorities, and should be referred to should any matter in this document require clarification.
- 3. The Charter establishes the Court, and states that the Court:
 - is the governing body of the University (Article 5.1);
 - is ultimately responsible for exercising all the powers of the University (Article 6.1); and
 - has powers, some of which it may not delegate. One such power that the Court retains to itself is to make final decisions on issues of corporate strategy (Article 7.4).
- 4. The Charter and the Statutes specify the powers and functions of the Senate as delegated by the Court. In particular, Charter Article 8.1 states that the Court delegates to the Senate all of its powers in relation to academic work and standards so that, subject to the terms of the Charter and the Statutes and to the powers reserved to the

Court, the Senate is the body responsible for the academic work and standards of the University and in relation to:

- Programmes of Study;
- teaching and research;
- the granting of awards; and
- the regulation and superintendence of the education and discipline of the Students.
- Statute 5.2 describes the majority of the detailed terms of reference of the Senate and these have been used as the section headings for the combined SSoPR/SSoDA.
- 6. Statute 5.4(a) permits the Senate to delegate any of its powers to any Committee which contains at least three of its members (at least one of whom should be an ex-officio member of the Senate). The quorum of any Committee of the Senate exercising delegated powers shall include at least two members of the Senate. Any further delegation of the delegated powers shall be defined and approved by the Senate, and prescribed in the Ordinances.
- 7. Unless otherwise stated, the definitions listed in the Charter (Article 2) shall apply in this document e.g.: "Students" means "persons pursuing a Programme of Study".
- 8. The phrase "Programme of Study" has the meaning given in Ordinance P7 (para 2.1)² and additionally, in the context of this

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- document, is taken to include higher doctorate degrees and research degrees by published works.
- 9. All instances of action taken under delegated authority must be reported to the Senate at the earliest opportunity.
- 10. In the attached table the first column lists each of the **Primary** Responsibilities of the Senate. These Primary Responsibilities are derived from, and contain actions intended to assist the delivery of, the powers and functions of the Senate as delegated by the Court (i.e. the Senate terms of reference).
- 11. The second column of the table lists the authorities which the Senate has delegated to its Standing Committees to undertake on its behalf. The table also lists powers that the Senate does not normally delegate.
- 12. The third column lists any **secondary delegations** from a Standing Committee to any sub-committee(s), and also contains explanatory notes from time to time.
- 13. Each Primary Responsibility of the Senate is supported in the Regulations as appropriate.
- 14. The various authorities delegated by the Senate are reflected in the terms of reference of the Standing Committees of the Senate.
- 15. The Standing Committees of the Senate are referred to in Ordinances C4 and C5. The Joint Committees of the Court and the Senate are described in Ordinance B9.
- 16. In situations where business must be conducted urgently or between its meetings, the Senate delegates to the Senate Committee for Interim Business and Effectiveness (SCIBE) the authority to discharge those powers and functions not delegated to any other Standing Committee of the Senate. The SCIBE undertakes these

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duties in accordance with its terms of reference, acting on behalf of the Senate.

- 17. Where any decision taken in accordance with this Statement is expected to have significant implications or is known to be sensitive, the Committee to which the authority is delegated will consult appropriately before exercising its delegation.
- 18. Any Committee to which power to act has been delegated can decide that it is not appropriate to exercise its delegation on a specific occasion and can refer the decision back to the Senate.
- 19. This document will be maintained on an ongoing basis by the Secretary of the University and any future delegations approved by the Senate are automatically added.
- 20. This document will formally be reviewed as part of each Effectiveness Review of the Senate to ensure that it remains relevant and appropriate. Any proposed additions or amendments to the SSoPR and/or the SSoDA arising from such a review will be subject to the approval of the Senate.
- 21. The Senate publishes its Statement of Primary Responsibilities and Statement of Delegated Authorities widely.
